President's Message

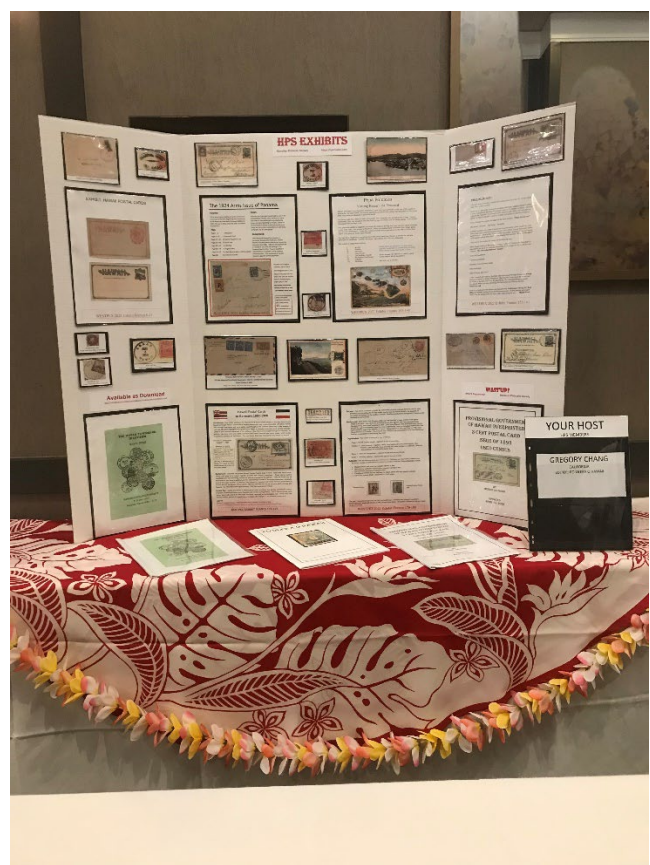
