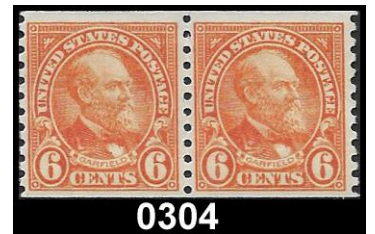

The vignette reproduced in a block of four on this souvenir card was taken from the original engraving prepared for the 25c Trans-Pacific Airmail stamp of 1935. This special stamp was issued primarily for use on mail matter dispatched by Trans-Pacific airmail service to Hawaii, Oahu, and the Philippine Islands. However, the stamp was also valid for use on regular airmail.

The central design is a representation of the sun rising from the shores of America, with a seaplane in flight over the ocean. A three-masted sailing vessel and a steamship typical of the middle nineteenth century period are shown in the distance. The shields of the United States and the Philippine Islands appear at the upper left and right, respectively.

Wildflowers that live in the Northeast often need to be able to grow in rocky soil and survive harsh winters. Some wildflowers from this region included in the complete pair of 50 (not necessarily among the stamps below) are the following:

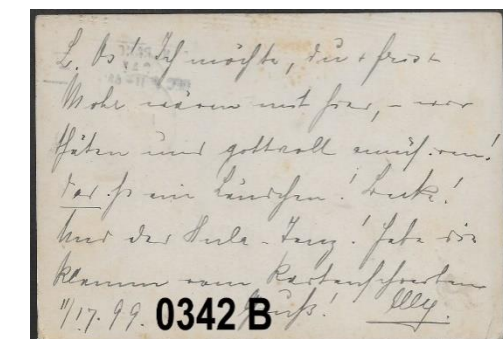
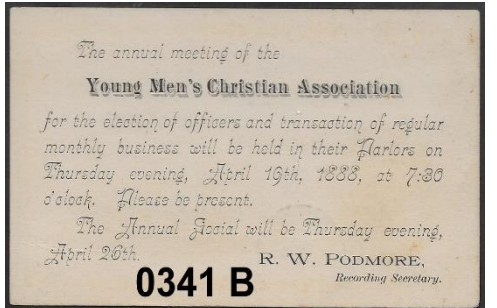
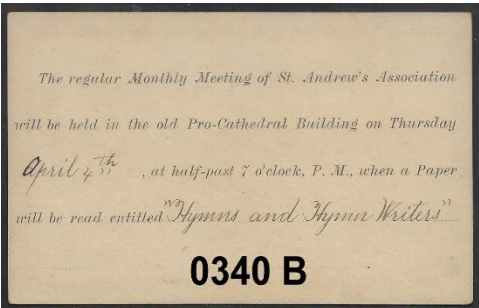
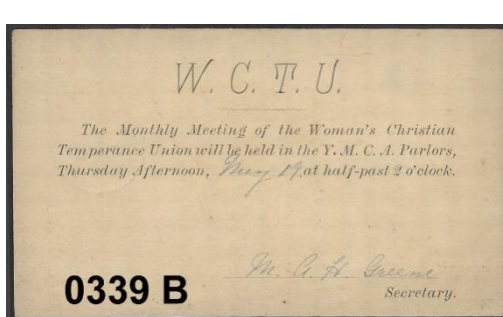
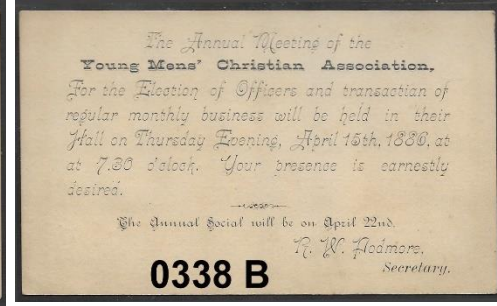
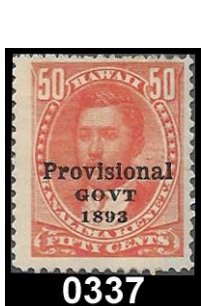
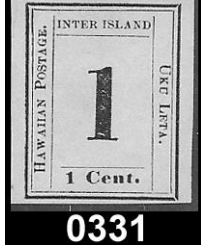
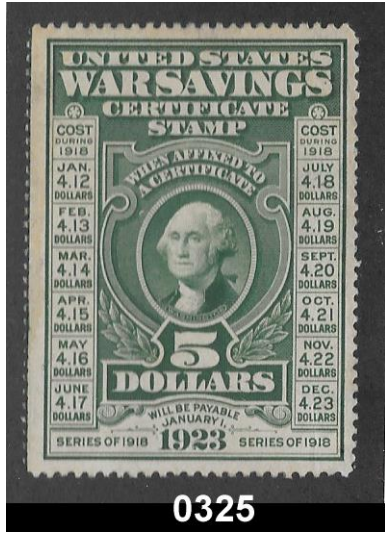
The Jack-in-the-box's unusual structure includes a hood, or spathe, surrounding a club-shaped spike at the base of which are five flowers. The plant grows over rocky woods.

Its diminutive size—with flowers 1/4 to 1/2 inch across—complements the delicacy of the blues. Each tubular flower has four lobes and a golden "eye" in the center.

Other hardy northeastern wildflowers are the Virginia Bluebell, Shooting Star, Turk's Cup Lily, and Dutchman's Pipe.
