### **HPS NOW ACCEPTS PayPal**

Payments to the Hawaiian Philatelic Society (HPS) for auction invoices, dues, website purchases and contributions can now be made using PayPal. The HPS Board felt this option was necessary because of the on-going problems with USPS. HPS and other organizations have had payments lost and delayed as well as possibly stolen.

To make a payment using PayPal, follow these steps.

1. Go to the PayPal home page (<https://www.paypal.com>). If you do not have a PayPal account, sign up by clicking on the "Sign Up" flag. Following the instructions on the displayed web page, establish an account. After you have established your account, log in to PayPal, and follow the steps to make a payment.
2. The payment should be made to the Hawaiian Philatelic Society at [hawaiistamps@hpshawaii.org](mailto:hawaiistamps@hpshawaii.org). For transactions, PayPal charges a small fee, which varies according to amount being transferred and currency.
